The Modern Slavery Act 2015 (“**the Act**”) came into effect on 29th October 2015. Usio Energy has put in place a new Anti-slavery and Human Trafficking Policy to reflect its commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all its business relationships. This includes implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls in order to minimize the risk of slavery and human trafficking taking place anywhere in its business or supply chains.

Usio Energy does not tolerate or support in any way any form of slavery or human trafficking through any part of its business or any part of its supply chain. Our policy is to act immediately, effectively, ethically and responsibly in every part of our business to ensure that slavery or human trafficking are not present in any part of our business.

Usio Energy’s prevention processes

At the end of each financial year, Usio Energy will undertake a review of every part of the business to identify any concern of slavery or human trafficking and will review in all parts of our supply chain similarly.

This policy is updated yearly and we will report to the relevant authorities any evidence found of slavery or human trafficking.

We will continue to ensure we maintain suitable methods of procurement of staff in effects to safeguard and actively prevent slavery and human trafficking.

We train all staff to be aware and understand the risks of slavery and human trafficking and actively keep clear reporting channels available to all staff to report anything suspicious.
